- Due to global bovine insulin raw material unavailability, Wockhardt has no choice but to withdraw the Hypurin® Bovine Insulin range. Unfortunately, despite our best efforts in trying to find an alternative supply of bovine insulin raw material, none was found. Wockhardt regrets any inconvenience this may cause but unfortunately the circumstances were beyond our control
- **PLEASE NOTE:** the withdrawal of Hypurin® BOVINE Insulin **does not** affect the supply of PORCINE insulin
- If you currently use any Hypurin® Bovine Insulin, please contact your diabetes healthcare professional so that appropriate changes can be made to your insulin therapy
