

What is so great about Wrexham/Wreccsam?

Well connected

Wrexham has good road and rail networks to many neighbouring cities. Trains run regularly to Chester, Liverpool and Manchester with two services daily to London. The A483 takes you to the historic walled city of Chester in just 20 minutes with bus links running every 10 minutes from the Wrexham General Bus station. Wrexham is approximately 13 miles (21 km) south of Chester, 30 miles (50 km) north-west of Shrewsbury, 50 miles (80km) south-west of Manchester, and 140 miles (230 km) north of Cardiff.

Historic Wrexham

Wrexham/Wreccsam is the largest town in the North of Wales and an administrative, commercial, retail and educational centre. Wrexham is situated between the Welsh mountains and the lower Dee Valley alongside the border with England. Historically part of Denbighshire, the town became part of Clwyd in the year 1974 and since 1996 has been the centre of the Wrexham County Borough. Wrexham has a rich and diverse heritage that is evidenced in its wealth of historic buildings, landscapes, towns and archaeology that represent the historical development, growth and adaptation of the county borough and the wider area over many centuries.

Education

There are many good nurseries, playgroups, primary and secondary schools in Wrexham, with both English and Welsh speaking schools to choose from. You can find more information via estyn.gov.wales

Glyndŵr University remains an accredited institution of the University of Wales and offers both undergraduate and postgraduate degrees. The university is named after the 14th century scholar and last Welsh Prince of Wales; Owain Glyndŵr and was formed with the North East Wales Institute (NEWI) and the North Wales School of Art and Design. The institution was founded in 1887 as the Wrexham School of Science and Art.

Coleg Cambria (previously known as Yale College / Coleg Iâl) is the main provider of adult education in Wrexham and is one of the largest colleges in Wales. As a tertiary college it also provides a wide range of higher education courses at Grove Park and Bersham Road campuses.

So what is there to do?

Wrexham Town Centre is forever improving with new wine bars, department stores, countryman pubs and hotels, not to mention it's home to Britain's oldest lager brew '**Wrexham Lager**'. The original brewery was founded in 1882 by German immigrants (Ivan Levinstein & Otto Isler) trying to recreate the lager taste that they missed from their homeland.

Wrexham has its own shopping centre in central Wrexham **Eagles Meadow**, which is now a medium-sized shopping centre that offers something for everyone, ranging from top retailer outlets & restaurant to cinema and bowling facilities.

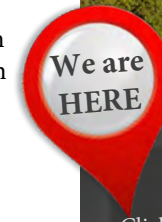
If sports is more your thing... Wrexham is home to the oldest international football stadium in the world and at the heart is the **Wrexham AFC (Red Dragons)**. It is the oldest club in Wales and the third oldest professional football team in the world founded in 1872. Also residing in Wrexham is the **North Wales Crusaders R.L.F.C.** a professional rugby league club founded in 2011, which is based at Queensway Stadium in Wrexham (as of 2017) #AchieveTogether.
